The Channel Islands cold storage facility is nestled on 6.5 acres of secured property. It provides 62,000 square feet of reliable and safe cold storage warehousing.

The CIL facility is merely two miles from the Port of Hueneme. The Port of Hueneme provides great advantage to its partner businesses because it is the only deep water Port between Los Angeles and the San Francisco Bay.

Channel Islands Logistics has been a contributing part of the Port's strategic growth. It services the harbor's largest customers such as Del Monte, Dole, Chiquita and Bonita.

Their facility has 101 plug-in slots for refrigerated containers. Last year CIL unloaded more than 2,000 containers from the Port of Hueneme, which is roughly 70 percent of all the containers that arrived at the Port.

The CIL is an authorized USDA inspection facility. Unlike the ports of LA/Long Beach, inspections at Channel Islands are performed in a refrigerated facility.

CIL has worked to establish a network of truckers capable of draying containers a few miles, or hauling refrigerated cargo across the country if need be.
