MINUTES

A meeting of the City of Port Hueneme and the Oxnard Harbor District City / Port Standing Committee was called to order at 4:00 p.m. on Monday, June 23, 2008, at 333 Ponomo Street, Port Hueneme, California.

ROLL CALL:

Present: Mayor Pro Tem Jonathan Sharkey, Council Member Murray Rosenbluth, and Commissioner Jess Herrera.

Absent: Commissioner Michael A. Plisky

MINUTES:

Council Member Rosenbluth moved to approve the May 29, 2008 meeting minutes as presented, seconded by Council Member Sharkey. The motion carried unanimously.

PRESENTATION OF SCAG TRUCK TRAFFIC STUDY

Mr. Bill Delo, of the IBI Group presented an overview of the Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG) Cities of Port Hueneme/Oxnard Truck Traffic Study and its findings.

Council Member Sharkey discussed the possibility of using the Navy Base Victoria Avenue Gate for truck use. The Harbor District Executive Director, Anthony Taormina responded that there is no access from the Port to the Victoria Gate and that the Navy limits the use to trucks that are associated with the Navy's outlease program.

Council Member Rosenbluth asked if this study had been review by the City of Oxnard. Mr. Bill Delo responded that the study would be presented by City staff to the Oxnard City Council in July.

The Harbor District Executive Director, Anthony Taormina reported that on July 16th the California Air Resources Board will be holding a meeting in our area to discuss air emission regulations and registration for all trucks that will go into effect in 2009 and invited City to participate.

ITEMS FOR FUTURE DISCUSSION:

Council Member Rosenbluth commented on the feasibility of combining Harbor Days with the Hueneme Beach Festival.
