ALL INTERESTED PARTIES ARE INVITED TO ATTEND AND PARTICIPATE IN THE DISCUSSIONS.

BACKGROUND: THE CALIFORNIA AIR RESOURCES BOARD (ARB) HAS SOLICITED APPLICATIONS FROM LOCAL AND STATE AGENCIES TO ADMINISTER FUNDING TO REDUCE EMISSIONS AND HEALTH IMPACTS FROM DIESEL EQUIPMENT USED TO MOVE FREIGHT IN CALIFORNIA'S FOUR PRIORITY TRADE CORRIDORS. THE OXNARD HARBOR DISTRICT HAS APPLIED TO ADMINISTER FUNDING IN THE LOS ANGELES / INLAND EMPIRE TRADE CORRIDOR IN THE CATEGORY OF "CARGO SHIPS AT BERTH AND CARGO HANDLING EQUIPMENT".

PURPOSE: A COMMUNITY WORKSHOP WILL BE CONDUCTED BY THE OXNARD HARBOR DISTRICT EXECUTIVE MANAGEMENT STAFF AT THE HEADQUARTERS OF THE DISTRICT TO SOLICIT INPUT FROM INTERESTED PARTIES WITHIN THE TRADE CORRIDOR FOR ELIGIBLE PROJECTS. IF SELECTED BY THE ARB AS AN ADMINISTERING AGENCY, THE DISTRICT WILL SOLICIT APPLICATIONS FROM INTERESTED PARTIES FOR SPECIFIC PROJECTS TO REDUCE EMISSIONS AND HEALTH IMPACTS FROM CARGO VESSELS AT BERTH AND CARGO HANDLING EQUIPMENT. THIS WORKSHOP IS INTENDED TO CONSIDER INPUT AS THE DISTRICT DEVELOPS THE DISTRICT'S LOCAL AGENCY PROJECT APPLICATION.

POTENTIAL PROJECTS: THE OXNARD HARBOR DISTRICT HAS IDENTIFIED ONE PROPOSED PROJECT WITHIN THE LOS ANGELES / INLAND EMPIRE TRADE CORRIDOR FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF INFRASTRUCTURE FOR SHIPS AT BERTH POWER FOR REFRIGERATED CARGO VESSELS CALLING AT THE PORT OF HUENEME. THE ESTIMATED PROJECT COST IS: \$ 11 MILLION. THE ESTIMATED ARB PROPOSITION 1 B FUNDING IS: \$ 5.5 MILLION. THIS IS AN OPPORTUNITY FOR THE DISTRICT TO IDENTIFY OTHER POTENTIAL PROJECTS, INCLUDING COSTS, MATCHING FUNDS AND BENEFITS.
