

Oxnard Harbor District Recognized Sixth Consecutive Year

For the sixth consecutive year the Oxnard Harbor District has been recognized by the Work/LIFE Project of Ventura County with the prestigious designation of “**Ventura County Family-Friendly Employer**”. The announcement was made at a ceremony held at Las Posas Country Club on June 4. The District was one of 21 organizations that were honored at the special luncheon. The District award was accepted by District Deputy Executive Director Judith Cofer.

The “Ventura County Family-Friendly Employer” designation is based on an employer’s commitment to its workforce. Selection is determined by very specific criteria measuring how an employer’s workplace practices and policies benefit its employees and their families.

The decision to honor the District was made a by the Business Work-Life Alliance of Ventura County’s Selection Committee whose members include the Ventura County Economic Development Association (VCEDA), the Economic Development Collaborative - Ventura County (EDC-VC), the Workforce Investment Board of Ventura County (WIB), the Business Work-Life Alliance of Ventura County, County Board of Supervisors and members of the Business Work/LIFE Alliance Board. Selection Committee members base their decisions on practices companies pursue that strengthen families and put into practice employment policies that help families balance their work and home responsibilities.

“We are very pleased and proud to have been selected for a sixth consecutive year”, said Ms. Cofer, “Selection for the designation of “Family-Friendly Employer” is not automatic”. Some of last year’s honorees were not honored this year. Every year the Selection Committee evaluates company and organizational policies for their ability to positively affect the lives of their employees and their families. The Oxnard Harbor District shares the distinct honor of being recognized along with companies and organizations that are at the forefront of organizational development and who have over the years seized opportunities that positively influence the lives of their employees and their families.
