



### **TSUNAMI SIREN TEST ON OCTOBER 2 AT NOON**

The Port Hueneme Police Department (PHPD) and Port of Hueneme Security will hold a joint test of the Port's Tsunami Warning System on Friday, Oct. 2 at 12 p.m. The Tsunami Siren will be activated by Port Security to ensure that the warning notification can be heard throughout the Port Hueneme inundation zone. The siren will sound for approximately two minutes.

PHPD will issue a Reverse 911 emergency notification call to residents and businesses located in the inundation zone on Thursday, Oct. 1, with information on Friday's test. Following the test, a second Reverse 911 call will remind residents and businesses that the sirens were a test of the tsunami warning system and ask them to press a number if they were or were not able to hear the sirens.
